

Greetings! UNICEF Philippines is grateful for our continued partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd) in advancing children's rights to quality education. DepEd and UNICEF Philippines have supported more than 11,000 learners and 900 teachers from 196 multigrade schools, as well as 1,000 parents and community stakeholders in various parts of the Philippines.

In partnership with your office and with generous support from Roche, UNICEF Philippines is currently implementing the multigrade school project ("Mitigating the Learning Crisis with Digital Learning for Children in Multigrade Schools in the Philippines"). As part of the project, UNICEF Philippines aims to develop a modelling canvas to support national policy implementation for scaling up. National policy implementation sometimes falls short at the local level - and local pilots too often fail to scale up nationally. This modelling approach aims to bridge this gap. By learning how interventions work at the local level and working in parallel with the government to replicate them on a national scale, we can have the best impact.
