DOWNLOADING OF THE FY 2024 SPECIAL NEEDS EDUCATION (SNED) PROGRAM SUPPORT FUNDS TO THE RECIPIENT DIVISIONS AND SCHOOLS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

All Others Concerned

- 1. Attached is DM-CT-2024-22 dated June 25, 2024 from the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Teaching, announcing the recipients of the 2024 SPED PSF which shall be downloaded to the respective divisions and implementing schools following the attached budget allocation.
- 2. As stipulated in DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2021 and as amended by DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2022, the recipient divisions and schools are directed to observe the guidelines and procedures on the utilization of the said funds based on the eligible expenses to ensure that the objectives of the program will be realized.
- 3. For this fiscal year, the divisions are advised to prioritize the utilization of funds for monitoring and evaluation of the program and conduct of trainings on SPED content and pedagogy, use of the Filipino Sign Language (FSL), development of the Individualized Education Plan (IEP), and use of the Multi-factored Assessment Tool (MFAT) while the schools are reminded to give emphasis on formal assessment and rehabilitation of learners with disabilities (LWDs) and acquisition of specialized devices and equipment for instructional purposes.
- 4. In view of this, the Regional Office, through the Finance Division and Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall download a total amount of **Fourteen Million Nine Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Pesos** (**Php 14,989,000.00**) to the 13 Schools Divisions as indicated in Enclosure A (Summary of the 2024 SNED PSF Budget Allocation for the Recipient Schools Divisions Offices and Implementing Schools).
- 5. The said amount shall be taken from the SNED Funds under Sub-Allotment Release Order No. OSEC-8-24-5157 dated July 18, 2024 which shall be valid for utilization until December 31, 2025.
- 6. The Schools Divisions Superintendents, with the help of the Division SNED Supervisors, shall see to it that the recipients, particularly the field schools, shall be oriented and given technical assistance on the proper utilization and liquidation the said funds.

- 7. To ensure easier tracking and proper utilization of funds, only one utilization report template attached in Enclosure B shall be used by all recipient divisions and schools.
