This is in reference to the implementation of the provisions of Republic Act (RA) 11650 otherwise known as "Instituting a Policy of Inclusion and Services for Learners with Disabilities in Support of Inclusive Education Act." The Bureau of Learning Delivery-Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) will conduct Workshops on the Refinement and Consultation with Stakeholders of Various Special Needs Education (SNED) Related Policies, on December 9-12, 2024, at National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) National Capital Region (NCR), 15 Cepeda Street, Concepcion 1, Marikina City.

Participants are experienced supervisors or school heads with a strong background in the implementation of disability-inclusive practices. Their contributions will be invaluable to the success of the said workshop.




