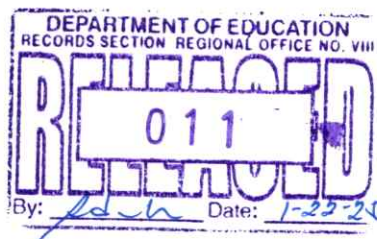
The target participants are senior high school learners, teachers, and practitioners.

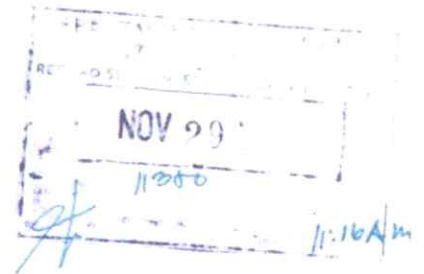
